	Richard Sagala Wine MBA is active in Italy (Verona, Vinitaly), and works in France (Paris, Kedge Business School), in Canada (University of British-Columbia <i>Wine Leaders Forum</i>) and Montréal (<i>École In Vino Veritas</i>); when not teaching, Richard Sagala works for the SAQ (Société des Alcools du Québec).

2-360 Degrees of wine related activities

Upon returning from Bordeaux after having completed his Wine MBA in 2011, Richard Sagala co-founded *École In Vino Veritas* a Wine and Spirit Education Trust (WSET) approved wine school in Montréal. On the 15th of January 2020, Richard received an email with the following comment assessing the school last eight years record as a WSET program provider and evaluating the quality of the training as well as the success rate of its students; it reads as follow: *«you have certainly demonstrated an outstanding commitment to quality and results »* Dave Rudman *Executive Director—WSET Americas*.

Last year, in 2019, Richard Sagala worked in Italy as a wine judge for the *Cinque Stelle* wine competition and contributed workshops on the theme of creative entrepreneurship to the Master of Science *Arts & Creative Industries* program of the Kedge Business School in Paris.

During the last sixth years in Canada, at UBC (the University of British-Columbia), Richard has conducted workshops and developed thematic tasting seminars on: *the quest for identity, quality and authenticity in wines* in the context of the *Wine Leaders Forum*, a yearly UBC-Kedge Bordeaux sponsored seminar dedicated to BC wine producers and vineyard owners.

Since 2012-13, École In Vino Veritas first academic year, Richard prepares wine professionals in Montréal and across Canada to sit the WSET exams. École In Vino Veritas is singular; besides offering WSET courses, it conducts wine business related academic research and presents its findings around the world making it the only private bilingual wine business school operating at graduate level accredited by the WSET in Canada. École In Vino Veritas research has called international media attention and the American Association of Wine Economists distinguished two of its papers, one in 2013 and one in 2016.

2017 saw the beginning of IMBA, the International Montreal Butler Academy, a school founded by Richard Sagala centered around first growths wine knowledge acquisition and fine wines cellar management techniques. IMBA business model is unique, no similar school in the world offers such a specialization. Named Sommelier in charge of creating and managing an investment grade fine wine cellar for Orford Music in 2018, Richard Sagala (an Orford Music past alumni) is now active in leveraging his business network to endow this highly reputed classical music Canadian institution (established in 1951).
